You will be asked to update your personal information before other sections of the website are available.




From the home screen, select Update Personal Details. There are 3 steps in this process:

Step 1 – Current Individuals: this shows a list of your household members.

Step 2 – New/Missing Household Members: allows you to add any missing individuals to your household list.

Step 3 – Address Information allows you to check and update your address and the relationships of the members to the head of the household.



Security
